This is a contractual agreement between the student, their parent(s) / guardian(s) and the Senior Army Instructor with regard to the JROTC (Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps) program.

- Is not a military recruiting program but a large 21st century information-age classroom;
Is an established program with more than 75 years of service;
Prepares cadets for adult life;
Increases stay-in-school and graduation rates; and
Requires a small investment per student compared to program benefits.

The JROTC curriculum teaches high school students the value of citizenship, leadership and service to the community with a sense of accomplishment. The JROTC mission statement, "to motivate young people to be better citizens" provides the focus.

Students in all Atlanta Public Schools' JROTC units must comply with the U.S. Army and high school directives in order to meet the standards of the course.

- Students must be present and in proper uniform at all major functions (Saber Day, Annual Inspection Day, Cadet Challenge, and Awards Day).
Students must follow the established rules, regulations, and procedures with regard to the wearing of the uniform and maintaining hairstyles in accordance with the rules and procedures outlined in Cadet Regulations.
Specifically, males are not authorized to wear ponytails, braids, cornrows, twists or dreadlocks or any other faddish hairstyle.
Failure to follow the rules and directives may result in not meeting course standards.
